OPINION AND ORDER

James F. Homer, doing business as Marin Transit Lines, is engaged in operating a passenger stage service between Sausalito and Marin City.^{1/} In this application he seeks the Commission's approval of a certificate of insurance issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing for coverage by Lloyd's of London for personal bodily injury and for property damage as required by the provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 101. The certificate provides for coverage in the amounts of \$15,000 and \$60,000 for bodily injuries and in the amount of \$10,000 for property damage.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission hereby approves the certificate of insurance issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing for insurance coverage for James F. Homer, doing business as

Marin Transit Lines, by Lloyd's of London, together with a renewal, or renewals, of said certificate.
