QRDER VACATING SUSPENSION SND INVESTIGATION ORDER
On Junc 24, 1952, Schedure No. G-2, Channels for Farmer Iines, together with Table of Contents, being CaI. P.U.C. Shects Nos. 1833-T to 1837-T, inciusive, of Citizens Utilitics company of California, filed under Advice Letter No. 99, was suspended until November 4, 1952 and on October 21, 2952 was further suspended untin May 1, 1953. Said filing added an additional teriff which will be applicable to a service presently being provided to Mr. Raymond H. Berry, the request for suspension having been made by Edward M. Berol, attorney for Mr. Berry.

Under date of Marcin 6, 1953 Mr. Berol adarcssed a lettor to the Commission stating:
"The above-cntitled and numberod mattor is set for hearing March 13, 1953. We have reached certain egrecments with counsel for Citizens Utilitics Compeny which will diepose of this issuc. Honee, our request ror suspension of the involved schedule is hereby withdrawn.
"It is rospectfuliy requested that the hearing be canceled and the proceeding be discontinued."

Accordingly, on March 9, 1953 the scheduled hearing was removed from the Comission's calendar. Inasmuch as the cause
