ORDER SETTING ASIDE SUBMISSION AND REOPENING FOR FURTHER HEARING.

The above-entitled matters were heard on a consolidated record on January 9, and 21, 1953, and both matters were duly submitted for decision. It now appears from evidence adduced at said hearings and from other information received by the Commission that there may be grounds not referred to in Decision No. 47813, dated October 14, 1952, in Application No. 31397, 1st and 2d Supplemental, for revoking the operative rights of said Dudley Atkins. An investigation to determine whether the operative rights of said Dudley Atkins should be revoked is today being instituted.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the submission heretofore entered in the above matters is set aside and both matters are reopened for further hearing before a Commissioner or Examiner and at such time and place as hereafter may be designated by notice of the Secretary.
