Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, Santa Ana Line, with State Highway Route VII-LA-167-A in Los Angeles County, California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route VII-LA-167-A (Los Angeles River Freeway) at separated grades under the track of Pacific Electric Railway Company's Santa Ana Line in the County of Los Angeles at the location as shown by map (Exhibit "B") attached to the application as amended, to be identified as Crossing No. 6N-11.75-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties, and copy of said executed agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two (2) years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date_hereof.
