## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Corey Lane, partially in the City of Sunnyvale and partially in the County of Santa Clara, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-39.7. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 8 crossing signs(General Order No. 75-B).

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied, with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public conventence, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served by this track has indicated a desire to commence operations by April 1, 1953; consequently the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
