OPINION AND ORDER

Southern Pacific Company seeks an order authorizing it to abandon and remove its stock corrals and fences at Merritt Station, County of Yolo.

The only protests received were from the Yolo County Wool Growers Association, California Wool Growers Association and the California Cattlemen's Association. Subsequently, such protests were withdrawn in writing.

Applicant alleges such stock corrals and fences are no longer necessary or of use to the general public.

Now therefore, a public hearing not being necessary and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon and remove its stock corrals and fences at Merritt Station, County of Yolo.

(2) That within thirty days of the abandonment and removal herein authorized, applicant shall notify the Commission in writing thereof.

(3) That the authority herein granted shall lapse if not exercised within one year from the effective date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
