Prion orders in this proceeding authorized appicant to deviate from the established minimum rates in connection with transportation scrvice performed for Sears, Rocbuck and Company within the Loe lageles area and between that area and other southern California points. The authority has expired. Applicant seeks its reinstatement, on a modified basis, for a one-year pe:10c.

Applicant alleges that except for increased operating coste the eonditions under which the service is performed have not materially changed. It groposes hizher rates than those formerly authorized and asserts that this adjustment of the rates will offset the increased costs. It further alleges that the proposed rates may reasonably be expected to result in profitable operations during the ensuins year.

Competing carriers have been notifice of the filing of the supplemental application. No objection has been offered to its beins granted.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that reinstatement of the outhority, as modifled herein, is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,
II IS HEREBY ORDERED that Signal Trucking Service, Iti. , be and it is heroby authorized to depart from the rates, rules and reguiations set forth in Highway Carriors' Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606 as amended) and in City Carriers' Tariff No. Hmighway Carriers' Tarifi No. 5 (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 32504 as amended) to the extent that alternative rates, rules, regulntions and conditions are provided in Appendix "A", attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereor.

III IS FEREBY FUNMER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire one year after the effectivedate of this order unzess sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.

APPENDIX "A" TO DECISION NO SSE62
IN APPLICATION NO. 27666 (SEVENTH SUPPLENENLAI)

Naming

Rates, rules, regulations, conditions and restrictions appicable to the transportation of property for Sears, Roebuck and Company.
(a) Between points witmin a radius of 45 constructive miles, computed in accordance with the provisions of Distance Table No. 4 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 46022, as amended, in Case NO. 4808), from the intersection of First and Main Streets, Ios Angeles; and
(b) (Applicable only to trancportation of property by shuttle delivery service) Between points as designated in above paragraph (a) on the one hand, and points within the corporate limits of the cities of San Diego, Riverside, San Bernardino, Ventura, Santa Barbara, and Oxnamd, on the other hamd.

The transportation services designated herein are described in Decision No. 41328 in Appiication No. 27666 (Second Supplementad).

Note 1. -- Weight in pounds is the greatest (heaviest) gross weight of the property transported by the unit of carrier's equipment at one time during a singie transaction. No allowance shail be made for weight of containers.

Note 2. -- (a) The total of the loading, unioading and driving time computed from the arrival of carricr's equipment at point of origin, or first point of origin when wore than one point of origin is involved, to the time uniouding is completed at point of destination, or last point of clestination when more than one point of destimation is involved, subject to paragraph (b) hereof, shall be used to compute charges.
(b) In computing time under the basis outined in paragraph (a) hereof the various time factors shall be not less than the actual time involved in minutes. After the total time has been determince under the provisions of paragraph (a) hercof, it shall be converted into hours and fractions thereof. Fractions of an hour shail be determined in accordance with the following table:


Note 3. -- Between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 2.m., and on Sundays or holidays, an additional charge at the rate of 215 cents per hour (or fraction thercoi) shail be assessed.

Column 1 - Rates in collars per unit of carrier's equapment for a period of five successive days or any portion thercof, excluding Sundays and holidays, and imited to 8 hours out of each 9 consecutive hours. When equipment is operated in excess of 250 miles during such period, add rates provided by column 5. When equipment is operated in excess of 8 hours in each 9 hours, add rates provided by Column 6.

Column 2 - Rates in dollars per unit of carrier's equipment for a period of six successive days or any portion thereof, excluding Sundays and holidays, and ismited to 8 hours out of each 9 consecutive hours. When equipment is operated in excess of 300 miles during such period, add rates provided by Column 5. When equipment is operated in excess of 8 hours in each 9 hours, ada rates provided by column 6 .

Column 3 - Rates in dollars per unit of carrier's equipment for a period of twenty-one successive days or, when the equipment is not operated on Saturdays, Sundays and holldays, for a period of twentyone successive days exciusive of Saturdays, sundays and holidays, or any portion of such periods. When equipment is operated in excess of 1,050 miles during the period, add rates provided by Column 5 . When equipment is operated in excess of 8 hours in any one day, add rates provided by Column 6.

Column + - Rates in dollars per unit of carriex's equipment for a period of twenty-five successive days or, when the equipment is not operated on Sundays and holidays, for a period of twenty-ifve successive days, exclusive of sundays and holidays, or any portion of such periods. When equipment is operated in excess of 1,250 miles during the period, add rates provided by Column 5. Then equipment is operated in excess of 8 hours in any one day, add rates provided by Column 6.

Column 5 - Rates in cents per mile to be added to the Column 1, 2, 3 and 4 rates when the unit of carrier's equipment is operated in excess of the maximum mileage allowed thereunder.

Column 6 - Rates in cents per hour to be added to the Column 1, 2, 3 and 4 rates when the unit of carider's equipment is operated in excess of the maximum hours allowed thereunder.

Note 1. -- Weight in pounds is the gross weight of the property transported by the unit of carrier's equipment at the time the equipment Is transporting the greatest (noaviest) $20 a d$ during the period covered by the transaction, No allowance shali be mads for welght of containers.

## SHUTTLE DELIVERY SERVICE - RULES AND REGUTATIONS

(a) Rates apply only for the transportation of property, regardiess of classification, between stores, warehouses or other properties owned, leased, operated, or controlled by Sears, Roebuck and Company.
(b) Rates are subject to Items Nos. 20,11 , and 150 series of City Carniers' Tariff No. 4, Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5. (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 32504, amended, in Case No. 4221).
(c) Rates are subject to an additional charge at the rate of $\$ 2.80$ per man, per hour, minimum charge $\$ 1.40$, when carrier furnishes heip in addition to the driver. The time for computing the additional charge shall be not less than the actual time in minutes the helper or helpers are engaged in performing the services. The total time so computed shall be converted into hours and fractions thereof. Fractions of an hour shall be determined in accordance with the following table:

Less than 8 minutes . . . . . . . . . . . . omit.
8 minutes on more but less than 23 minutes shall be $1 / 4$ hour.
23 minutes or more but less than 38 minutes shall be $1 / 2$ hour.
38 minutes or more but less than 53 minutes shall be $3 / 4$ hour.
54 minutes or more shall be 1 hour.
(d) Signal Trucking Service, Itd., shall issue, for each vehicie furnished, a shipping document containing a certification that during the period covered by the document the vehicle was operated oniy in transportation service for which rates are herein provided (or full expianation of other operations, with reference to shipping documents covering); showing rates and charges assessed; and containing all such information respecting each of the factors entering into the computation of the charges as may be necessary to verify the lawfulness of the charges assessed. Signal Irucking Service, Itd., shail retain and preserve a copy of each such shipping document, subject to the Commission's inspection, for a period of not less than three years from the date of its issuance.
(e) Charges on shipments transported in shuttle delivery service to or from San Diego, Riverside, San Bernardino, Ventura, Santa Barbara, and oxnard shall not be less than those applicable to shipments of 12,000 pounds.
(土) Charges on shipments transported in shuttle delivery service to or from San Diego, Riverside, San Eemardino, Ventura, Santa Barbara, and oxnard shall be constructed by adding to the charge computed at the rates provided on page 3 in Colums 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and/or 6, any charge accrued or paid for drivers' wages which is in excess of the charge which would have accrued at the regular andor overtime wage rates in effect on Narch. 1, 1953, for drivers engaged in making deliveries in shuttie deifvery service in accordance with provisions of Decision No. 41870 , as amended, in this proceeding, within the area described in paragraph (a) on First Page of this appendix.

## DE LTXX DELIVERY SERVICE

The rate for the delivery of shipments in de iuxe delivery service will be $\$ 1.55$ per 200 pounds to all points within the delivery zone, except:
a. To Calabasas, Newhall, Saugus, and Sylmar areas $\$ 2.00$ per 100 pounds;

1.. \$1. 76 in adaition to the transportation charge is to be assessed for installation of all gas ranges. Shipper is to fumish all material.
2. $\$ 1.55$ per hundred pounds on ald uncrated water heators.
3. A flat fee of $\$ 1.55$ is to be charged when pickup has been ordered but not completed for some stated reason from either in-zone or outside locations.
A flat charge of $\$ 2.55$ will be made for call backs to complete instaliations or other service not provided at time of delivery, when such call backs are not made for the convenience of the carr£er.
4. $\$ 7.43$ per hour is to be charged for all lost time when shown as actual lost time by irregularity report attached to bill of lading by delivering driver. This includes out-of-zone deliveries.
5. The charges for collecting and remitting the amount of C.O.D. bills collected on C.O.D. shipments shail be computed in accordance with the provisions of Item No. 250 semies of City Cariers' Tariff No. 4 , Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5. (Appendix. A to Decision No. 32504 , as amended, in Case NTO. 4121.)
6. Rates inciude second or third attempt delivery.
7. $\$ 2.48$ per mundred pounds will be charged for the discornecting and return of refrigerator power units to Sears" Warehouse.
8. $\$ 2.48$ per hundred pounds will be charged for delivery and instailation of refrigcrator power units.
9. Jawn swings - setting up charge will be $\$ 2.97$.
20. Dryers - installation charge will be $\$ 1.76^{\circ}$.
11. Deep Freezers - $\$ 2.42$ per hundred pounds --sizes measuring 14 cu. fit. and over. Others of less cubic foot measure $\$ 1.55$ per hundred pounds.

## DE LUXE DELIVERY SERVICE

12. Where additional heip is required or requested for delivery and installation on items such as home freezers or other similar items, the charge will be $\$ 2.80$ per man, per hour, minimum charge $\$ 2.40$, for help in addition to driver and one helper.

## MAIL ORDER SERVICE

Class rates in cents per 100 pounds applicable to the transportation of shipments having both point of origin and point of destination within the Ios Angeles Drayage Area, as described. In Items Nos. 30 to 33 series, inciusive, of City Carriers Tariff No. 4 and Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended, in Case No. 4121).
