OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant operates as a public utility warehouseman. By this application it seeks authority to suspend service at one of its San Francisco warehouse locations. Applicant states that the lease it held on these premises has expired and that authority to suspend service for a period of one year or less is sought to permit the acquisition of 69,683 square feet of equivalent floor space.

The Warehousemen's Association of the Port of San Francisco has advised the Commission that it does not object to the proposed suspension.

The granting of temporary authority to suspend service is justified at this time. The suspension will be limited to a one-year period as proposed by applicant and made subject to such earlier cancellation, change or extension as circumstances may require. Applicant will be expected to make diligent efforts to acquire floor space equivalent to that covered by this suspension authority at the earliest possible date or to relinquish its operating rights to the extent of the amount of space involved.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Robertson Drayage Co., Inc., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to suspend the

operation of 69,683 square feet of warehouse floor space in San Francisco and that this authority shall expire one year after the effective date hereof unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
