O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional drill track and relocate the existing drill track at grade across Lassen Avenue in the City of Huron in Fresno County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BD-280.0. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by four existing reflectorized Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Applicant is also authorized to construct an additional drill track and an additional spur track at grade across Ninth Street in said City of Huron at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BD-280.2-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two reflectorized Standard No. 1 crossing signs.

(G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
