ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across 12th Street in the City of Chino, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BAB-520.42-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industries to be served by this trackage request that it be placed in service by June 1, 1953, in order to meet rail shipments anticipated at the beginning of the potato season. For this reason, the effective date of the order shall be the date hereof.
