O R D E R

Union Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Fremont Street, in the County of Riverside, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 3-53.43-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
