In the Matter of the Application of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF KERN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, for an Order authorizing the construction of a crossing by the County of Kern over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, approximately 3589 feet north of Mile Post 318, Kern County, California.

ORDER

The County of Kern is authorized to construct Brundage Lane at grade across the main line track of the Arvin Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Bakersfield, Kern County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BQ-317.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two reflectorized Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
