 Sacramento Northern Railroad at Acacia Avenue)

**O R D E R**

City of North Sacramento is authorized to construct Acacia Avenue at grade across the Main Line of Sacramento Northern Railway in the City of North Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 8-96.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 4 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by 2 Standard No. 1-A crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B). Adequate culverts for drainage shall be provided.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
