Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of two crossings at separated grades of tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, San Joaquin Valley Linc, with State Highway Route VII-LA-4-LA,F, Los Angeles County, California, and abandonment of an existing crossing, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Veldon Canyon Overhead".

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The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route VII-LA-4-LA,F, at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company near the City of San Fernando, Los Angelos County, in the manner and at the locations as shown by Exhibits "A", "B", and "C" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-456.2-A for the Weldon Canyon Overhead and Crossing No. B-458.1-A for Routes 4-157 Separation and Overhead. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties, and copy of said executed agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commoncing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

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authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date horeof. ρ
