ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Bandini Boulevard at grade across one main track and one spur track of the Laguna line of the Los Angeles Junction Railway Company in the County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 25C-4.19. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Los Angeles Junction Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 20 feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs with reflex reflecting sheet material (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within

one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
