ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional drill track and an additional run-around track at grade across Vine Street in Sacramento County, erroneously described in the application as being located in the City of Sacramento, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-91.21-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
