FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By the terms of the Commission's order of its Decision No. 48388, dated March 24, 1953, in the above-entitled proceeding, applicant, City of Vernon, was required to bear the entire expense of constructing the proposed crossing. The Commission is now advised that the railroad has agreed to bear a portion of the construction and maintenance cost.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the statement contained in the first paragraph of said Decision No. 48388 reading as follows:

"Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails."

is modified to read as follows:

"The construction and maintenance cost shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement between applicant and Union Pacific Railroad Company."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall file with the Commission within thirty days after the date hereof, a copy of said agreement relative to division of cost of constructing

and maintaining said crossing.

In all other respects said Decision No. 48388 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
