Overhead.

ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works is authorized to construct State Highway, Road VI-Tul-4-F, at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near Goshen, Tulare County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-240.8-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within ninety days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances, except overhead clearance, shall conform to the provisions of General Order 26-D. Overhead clearance shall conform to Condition No. 9 of the order in Decision No. 41264 in Application No. 29051, dated March 2, 1948.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
