O R D E R

County of Sacramento is authorized to relocate the Hood-Franklin Road at grade across the Walnut Grove Branch Line of Southern Pacific Company near the town of Hood, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AU-104.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs. (General Order No. 75-B) or by two Standard No. 1 signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting.

Upon completion, Crossing No. AU-104.5 located about twenty-nine feet south of the proposed relocation shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
