ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across both Avenue in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-11.6. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue new graded, with tops of rails flush with the readway and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 percent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one

year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be reveked or medified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
