FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION & ORDER

By Decision No. 48606 the applicant, Henry Landshut, was granted authority to operate a passenger stage service in the vicinity of Lake Elsinore, Riverside County, subject to the requirement that he institute service within 65 days after the effective date of the order.

Applicant has now advised the Commission that due to a delay in the delivery of a bus he will not be able to inaugurate service before Soptember 1, 1953, and requests an extension of time in which to establish service.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 48606 is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. Within 100 days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
