## OPINION AND ORDER

John J. Valine, doing business as Norco Transportation Co., is engaged in operating a petroleum irregular route carrier service in the State of California. In order to meet his obligations for personal liability and property damage he has obtained a certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Co., providing for coverage with Lloyd's of London in the amounts of \$25,000 and \$50,000 for bodily injury liability and in the amount of \$25,000 for property damage. In this application, filed pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 5 of the Commission's General Order No. 100, he seeks approval of such certificate.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, that the amounts of insurance coverage provided in said certificate of insurance meet the requirements of General Order No. 100, and that an order should
