## ORDER

City of Walnut Crook is authorized to construct Nowell Avenue at grade across San Ramon Branch of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Walnut Crook, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BO-48.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet cutside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not loss than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (General Order No.75-B). The existing bank of earth and rock in the southwest quadrant shall be removed, thereby affording better visibility.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advice the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public
