<u>o p i n i o n</u>

The California Dump Truck Owners Association and the San Bernardino-Riverside Counties Rock Products Association, petitioners herein, request the establishment of certain production areas, delivery zones and zone rates, for the transportation of rock, sand, gravel, decomposed granite and asphaltic concrete by dump trucks in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. The applicable tariffs do not provide for zone rates between the various points of production and consumption of rock, sand, decomposed granite and asphaltic concrete in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties and points in the urban area within those

counties, with the exception of some zones in the San Bernardino mountain area near and including Lake Arrowhead and Big Bear Lake. Other than for these zones in the mountain area, the only applicable rates are hourly rates and mileage rates. It is alleged that the mileage rates are unduly high for hauls over level terrain, that the hourly rates require excessive truck supervision and tend to make bidding on contract jobs a difficult and precarious procedure for the shippers, and that these factors are disadvantageous to the for-hire truckers.

A public hearing was held on May 15, 1953, before Examiner Syphers at San Bernardino, at which time evidence was adduced and the matter submitted.

The executive secretary of the San Bernardino-Riverside Counties Rock Products Association testified that the association desires the establishment of official zones and production areas, together with the establishment of minimum rates applicable thereto. He stated that under the present rates the shippers find it advantageous to perform their own transportation and that about 95 per cent of the sand and gravel and about 60 per cent of asphaltic concrete are hauled by proprietary carriers.

This witness introduced and explained Exhibit 1, which is a map showing the area of San Bernardino and Riverside Counties within the delivery area of the San Bernardino-Riverside Counties Rock Products Association. On this map is outlined the boundaries of the production areas. Exhibits 2 and 3 contain descriptions of the areas as outlined on Exhibit 1. Exhibit 4 is a map showing the same zone areas as are shown on Exhibit 1 but, in addition, Exhibit 4 contains the results of a time traverse. In other words, this exhibit shows the time, in minutes, required by trucks to traverse the principal highways between

various points on the map. The traverse times were determined by special studies made by the association with the cooperation of the Commission's staff. Studies were made also to determine the average time required to load and unload the vehicles. For the purpose of developing zone rates in connection with the times as determined by the studies, the witness was of the opinion that costs of between \$6.50 and \$6.60 per hour would produce reasonable rates for 3-axle dump trucks of the type most commonly used in the area.

The witness stated that, while there are several delivery zones already established in the San Bernardino mountain territory, he believed that these zones could be designated so as to distinguish them from any number of zones which might be established as a result of this application.

The manager of the California Dump Truck Owners
Association presented testimony and stated that the organization which he represents supports the instant proposals. All of the permitted dump truck carriers in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties were notified of this proposal by the California Dump Truck Owners Association and two meetings were held in the vicinity of San Bernardino. At each of these meetings the membership of the association supported the instant proposal and there was no opposition.

This witness also presented Exhibit 5, which is a study of the cost of operation of a typical 3-axle dump truck. In this study he arrived at a figure of \$6.62 per hour as representing present costs plus an allowance for reasonable profit. He discussed the various formulas which have been advanced from time to time relating to the establishment of dump truck rates and for the purposes of this proceeding he

advocated the use of a formula referred to in Exhibit 1124 in Case No. 4808.

An associate transportation engineer of the Commission's staff presented Exhibit 6, a study of round-trip running times between production areas and proposed delivery zones, Exhibit 7, a report on a study of operations of dump truck equipment in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties, and Exhibit 8, which is a tabulation of one-way mileages from production area "H" into delivery zones in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties.

An examination of all of the evidence adduced herein leads us to the conclusion and we now find that zone rates for the transportation of rock, sand, gravel, decomposed granite, asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture should be established for application in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. The cost and time data of record herein provide a satisfactory basis for the establishment of just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory zone rates. Zone rates developed from such data, with modifications, are provided by the ensuing order. Petitioners' recommendations regarding the limits of the proposed production areas and delivery zones will be adopted with certain modifications in the descriptions thereof which will be made for purposes of clarification and to reflect current street and avenue designations. The present delivery zones in the San Bernardino mountain area will be renumbered. A rule in City Carriers'

In connection with shipments from production area "H", the witness suggested the formula be applied on a modified basis. This production area lies partly in Los Angeles County and partly in San Bernardino County and the modifications were recommended so as to provide an orderly relationship as between the zone rates which may be established in San Bernardino County and the present zone rates from production area "H" to Los Angeles County delivery zones.

Tariff No. 6, Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 providing for a combination of zone and distance rates will be amended to reflect the delivery zones hereinafter provided.

ORDER

A petition as above entitled having been filed herein, public hearing having been held thereon and the Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 6, Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7, be, and it is, hereby amended by incorporating therein the original and revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix, by this reference, are made a part hereof.

This order shall become effective August 10, 1953.
