ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Commission Decision No. 40553, dated July 22, 1947, that Vernon L. Thorson, doing business as Thorson Stage Lines, was authorized to establish and operate a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Hanford and Tulare via Odessa, Guernsey, Corcoran, Waukena and intermediate points; it further appearing that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage is now on file with the Commission by said Vernon L. Thorson, as required by General Order No. 101; and it further appearing that the passenger stage service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations; therefore, it is found that Vernon J. Thorson is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage operation.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the certificates transferred and issued to Vernon L. Thorson, doing business as

Thorson Stage Lines, by Decision No. 40553 in the above-entitled proceedings are hereby revoked, and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Vernon L. Thorson, doing business as Thorson Stage Lines, are hereby canceled.

The secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Vernon L. Thorson.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Vernon L. Thorson, unless said Vernon L. Thorson before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
