ORDER

The County of Fresno is authorized to widen and reconstruct the crossing of Clovis Avenue at grade with a track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, (Crossing No. 2V-65.5) near Fresno, Fresno County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-eight feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) or by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
