O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Sacramento and East Anderson Streets, both unimproved streets in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Sacramento and East Anderson Streets are not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such openings.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that industry desiring spur track is incurring additional expense by having to load and unload from public team track facilities and requests that authority be made effective as of this date.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
