## OPINION

John h. Ragghianti sceks an order authorizing him to construct a private crossing at grade over the tracks of the Sacramento Northern Rallwey near Lafayette in the maner delinoated on a mep attached to the application.

Public hearings were beld at Lefayette before Examincr Silverhart on June 23 and July 20, 1953, on which iattor date the matter was submitted.

Appilcantrs property, consisting of approximatoly two acros dividod into four irreguiariy shapod lots, is situetod wosteriy of and abuts upon tho railroad right of wey. Such proporty. 1s distent 292 fect westoriy from Los Palos Drive, a public road some 132 foct cestorly of tho reilroad tracks. Los Palos Drive runs gencraily in a northeriy and southorly diroction through Gicasido Estatos. Los Trompos. Crook flows along and over the Foor boundary linc. St. Mary's Rocd is distant approximately 300 foet westorly from applicent's westeriy property Iinc: It apponss from the record that applicont's proporty is complotely onclosed by
other private property with no access to a pubilc highway. Ingross to and egress from Los Palos Drive can be accomplished oniy by crossing the railroad tracks and continuing over land located in Gicnside Estatos. Egross. Irom and ingress to St. Mary's Road can only be obtained by crossing the ercok and passing orer private property.

Lt a cost of $\$ 3,300$ applicant has acquired an coscment for a right of way 30 fect wide over the southerly 15 foet of Lot 39 and the northorly 15 feet of Lot 40 in Glenside Estatos oxtonding from the railroad right of way to Los. Palos Drive. Ho doos not possess any rights permitting pessage from his property to St. Mary's Roect.

The rood commissioner of the Country of Contre coste
tostificd that tho Strects and Exghways Codo requires all county highways to be at loast 40 foct in width and would thorefore prohibit tho accoptance of the above-doscribod 30-f00t eascmont as a county road. The withess statod that the construction of a bridge and the acquisition of a right of why would bo requirod in order to utilizo St. Mary's Roed es on outlet from or inict to applicant's property. He estimatod the cost of such a bridge, without provision for right of way or contingoncios, at $\$ 7,500$ to $\$ 12,000$.

Applicantis agont, a ronl ostate broker, tostiflod that without eceoss to Los Palos Drive the lots here involvece could bo valucd oniy on the besis of $\$ 250$ per acre. With such accoss, bo stetod, oach lot would bo worth from $\$ 5,000$ to $\$ 6,000$ oach. The witness stated that only onc residence is to be constructod on anch iot. Lecording to the witness, the proposed crossing and the right of wey to Los Paios Drivo will bo usod oniy by the ownors of such rosidoncos, thoir familios, guosts, and tradospeoplo having businoss with them, and not by the genoral publio:

The Sacramento Northorn Reilway did not tostiry or call any witnessos.

The record indicatos that the proposod crossing is a private one within the purviow of Soction 7537 of the pabile Jtilitios Coce and is reasonably nocessary for fingress to and egress from appizent!s property. The record further domonstrates thet sconomicaliy it would not be pructicable to utilize St. Meryis Road as a means of accoss to and from such property: The application will be granted as sot forth in the onsuing order:

## ORDER

Public hoarings having boen held and basod upon tho evidence theroin adduced,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That Jown he Ragehianti is authorized to construct a privetc crossing ot grode with tho tracks of the Secramento Northem Raliwny at the locetion more perticuinciy outined and in the mannor delincatex upon the drawings attechod to tho application subject to and only upon the following conditions:
(a) The ontiro oxponse of constructing the crossing shail be borne by applicant.
(b) Said crossing shail be constructod oquel or superior to type shown as Standerd No. 2 in Goneral Orcor No. 72 and shin bo icontified in tho menner promided by Soction IV of Genorni Orcicr No. 75-E.
(c) Applicant shall orect a sign, 2 foet by 2 foct, festencd to a suitable post 5 foct in height, berring the legenc "Private Rond - Not for Public Use", on Los Pmios Drive at the northeasterly corner of the $30-f 00 t$ right-of-way cosemont eepieted in the drawings roforrod to in percgraph (1) horcof.
(d) The cost of maintaining those portions of the crossing up to ifnos 2 foct outsice of the outsico rails should be borme by appiscent. The cost of maintemence betwoon seic lines shell be borme by tho Seeramento Northern Rajlway.
(2) Within thirty days thereafter applicant shall give the Commission written notice of tho completion of tho installation of: sale crossing and of his compliance with tho conditions horoof.
(3) Tho authorization horoin grantod shell lapse if not excrassce within ono your from tho dato horeof, unless furthor time Is granted by subsoquont order:

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
