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FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 48875, dated July 28, 1953, the Commission authorized Bakersfield Transit Co. to execute a conditional sale contract providing for payments of \$34,907.12 for the purchase of equipment. The order of the Commission provided that the authorization thus granted would become effective when applicant paid a fee of \$35.

It appears that the contract will be in the amount of \$27,936.00 and that the fee payable under the provisions of Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code will be \$28; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Ordering paragraph 1 of the order in Decision No. 48875, dated July 28, 1953, hereby is amended to read as follows:

"1. Bakersfield Transit Co., on and after the effective date hereof and on or before December 31, 1953, may execute a conditional sale contract, in substantially the same form as that filed in this proceeding, providing for payments of approximately \$27,936.00, for the purpose of acquiring two new passenger coaches."

2. Ordering paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 48875, dated July 28, 1953, hereby is amended to read as follows:

"3. The authority herein granted will become effective when Bakersfield Transit Co. has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$28.00."

3. This first supplemental order will become effective upon the date hereof.
