DEFORD THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the latter of the Application of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF KERN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, for an order Authorizing the Widening of a Crossing by the County of Kern over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, and the installation of flashing light grade crossing signals, approximately 2640 feet East of Mile Post 316, Kern County, California

ONDER

The County of Norm is authorized to widen and reconstruct the crossing of Fairfax Road at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. B-316.5) near Bakersfield, Kern County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-eight feet and grades of approach not greater than nine percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two fectoutside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,

or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
