BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the County of Fresno, State of California, for permission to widen an existing public highway crossing at grade across the right of way and track of the FRESNO-FAMOSO LINE of the SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD, at its intersection with Clovis Avenue between Minnewawa Avenue and Fowler Avenue in Fresno County, California.

ORDER

The County of Fresno is authorized to relocate and widen the crossing of Clovis Avenue at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. BC-211.0) near Fresno, Fresno County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-eight feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1A crossing signs, (G.O. No. 75-B) or by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
