O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct at grade (1) a side track across "A" and "B" Streets, (2) a drill track across "C" Street, and (3) relocate a spur track across "C" Street in the City of Hayward, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossings Nos. 4-20.2 ("A" Street), 4-20.3 ("B" Street), and 4-20.4 ("C" Street). Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 8 and No. 3 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

The side track at "A", "B" and "C" Streets shall be connected to actuate the existing crossing signals at said streets and the drill track at "C" Street shall also be connected to actuate the existing crossing signal at "C" Street.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or
safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after
the date hereof.
