FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 48815 of July 14, 1953, in this proceeding, authorized Antelope Valley Refrigerating Co., a corporation, upon dissolution of its affairs, to transfer its public utility warehouse property at Palmdale to Henry William Schafer, Frances Louise Schafer and Charles C. Chandler, Jr., a partnership, doing business as Antelope Valley Refrigerating Co.

By supplemental application authority is now sought to effect the transfer without the necessity of dissolving the corporation. It is represented that it is to the advantage and best interest of the corporation to continue its existence.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought amendment of the authority should be granted. So that the transfer may be effected as soon as possible, the order herein will be made effective immediately.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first ordering paragraph of Decision No. 48815 of July 14, 1953, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. Antelope Valley Refrigerating Co., a corporation, may transfer to Henry William Schafer, Frances Louise Schafer and Charles C. Chandler, Jr. the public utility properties referred to in this application."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 48815 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
