ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 38671, dated February 13, 1946, that Caltransit Lines, a California corporation, was authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation in and about the City of Watsonville; it further appearing that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage has ever been filed with the Commission by said Caltransit Lines, as required by General Order No. 101; and it further appearing that the passenger stage service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations; therefore, it is found that Caltransit Lines, a corporation, is no longer conducting and has unlawfully abandoned said passenger stage operation,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Caltransit Lines, a corporation, by Decision No. 38671 in the above-entitled proceeding is hereby revoked, and all effective and applicable tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Caltransit Lines, a corporation, are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Caltransit Lines, a California corporation.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Caltransit Lines, a corporation, unless said Caltransit Lines before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
