## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

 don the Class "D" non-agency station of

 side track approximately 3,245 feet in  
 length located at said non-agency station.

**O R D E R**

The verified joint application of Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company filed on August 4, 1953, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicants' station of Conman during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company are authorized to abandon their non-agency station of Conman, County of Lassen; to remove a side track of approximately 3,245 feet in length at said station; to eliminate said name from their station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicants shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
