O R D E R

The City of Santa Clara is authorized to construct Martin Avenue at grade across tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. L-43.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G.O. No. 75-B).

The application also requested authority to construct crossings at grade over the same tracks at Walsh Avenue and Mathew Street. There does not appear to be a clear need for such crossings at the present time. Therefore, the request for authority to construct crossings at Walsh Avenue and Mathew Street will be denied without prejudice. The applicant has stated that such a course of action is satisfactory. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in

writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
