ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Fourth Stroot in the City of Patterson, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. RA-107.6-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superclevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street new graded, with tops of rails flush with the readway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant has stated that the industry to be served has requested

immediate construction of the proposed spur track in order to ship perishable produce during the present harvest season, therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
