ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 37179, dated July 11, 1944, in Application No. 26133 that Glenn W. Naylor was authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Bishop, California, and the California-Nevada State Line, and intermediate points, and between Big Pine, California, and the California-Nevada State Line, and intermediate points; it further appearing that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage is now on file with the Commission by said Glenn W. Naylor, as required by General Order No. 101; and it further appearing that the passenger stage service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations; therefore, it is found that Glenn W. Naylor is no longer conducting and has unlawfully abandoned said passenger stage operation.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Glenn W. Naylor by Decision No. 37179 in the above-entitled proceeding is hereby revoked, and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Glenn W. Naylor are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Glenn W. Naylor.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Glenn W. Naylor, unless said Glenn W. Naylor before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
