BEFORE TEE PUBIIC UTILITIES COMISSION OF THE STATE OF CAIIFORNIA
In the matter of the application of
GIESON LINES, a corporation, for a
certificate of public convenience
and necessity, authorizing an exten-
sion of ivs existing operating rights
as a Passenger Stage Corporation be-
tween Sacramento, West Sacramento, and
the North Sacramento arca, and to con-
solidate such operation with the
remainder of appicent's transportation
system.

## QPINIQN

In the above-entitied proceeding Gibson Innes requests authority to extend its passenger stage service between Sacramento and North Sacramento to a newly developed housing area at North Sacramento known as MeCleilan Meadows. It also requests authority to establish certain additional routings in the Broderick-West Sacramento areas now served by it.

In support of those requests applicant asserts that it has had numerous locel requests to extend service to McClellan Meadows. Its proposal to estabilish additional routings in the Broderick-West Secramento arcas is the result of numerous complatnts received from various civic groups in those areas that its service is now inadequate to the extent thet the arrangement of its routes in those arcas does not properly serve numerous riders duning peak hours. To mect those complaints applicant proposes to ostablish certain peak-hour tripper services over the proposed additional routes. This will provide for shorter, more direct worker service desired and 21so provide service to new housing areas not previousiy served.

Applicant states that if the peak-hour service justifies acditional service it would be established over those routes. Present
farcs would be applicable over all new routings proposed.
After full consideration of applicant's request the Comission finds that public convenience and necessity require the proposed extensions of service, which will be authorized. No public hearing appears to be necessary.

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An application as above-entitied having been filled and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED that Route 3 as set forth in Paragraph 2(c) of the order of Decision No. 40469 in Appiication No. 28389 is hereby deleted therefrom and the following described route substituted in the place thereor:

## "Route 3

Over applicant's presently certificated routes from Sacramento to North Sacramento along Del Paso Boulevard to its intersection with El Camino Avenue, North Sacramento; thence along Del Paso Boulevard to its intersection with N. 22nd Street; thence along N. 22nd Street to its intersection with Grand Avenue; thence east on Grand Avenue to its intersection with Antelope Road; thence north along Antelope Road to Gate No. I at MeClellan Fleld; thence north along Antelope Road to its intersection with Watt Avenue; thence north on Wett Avenue to its intersection with Eye Street, MeClelian Meadows."
II IS FURTHER ORDERED that Route 7 as defined in Paragraph 2(c) of Decision No. 40469 in Application No. 28389 at sheet il thereof and as amended by Decision No. 45488 in Appilcation No. 32157 is heroby further amended in its entirety to read as follows:
"Route? 7
Begianing at applicant's depot at sacramento; thence westeriy aiong "I" Street to 3rd. Street (Broderick); thence over 3rd Street, State Highways Nos. 16 and 24 , Bryte Avenue, Riverbank Rood, Weter Street, Stato Highways Nos. 16 and $2^{2}$, Reed Street, Harbor Bouzevara, U. S. Highways Nos. 40 and $99-W$, Park Boulevard, Alameda Boulovara, Alabama Avenue, 16 th Street, Virginia Avenue, 15th Street, South River Road, Riske Iane, 5 th Street, to intersections with State Highways Nos. 16 and 24.
"From the intersection of $32 t h$ and "I" Street in Sacramento; thence south on 12th Street to "J" Street; thence west on "J" Street to 6 th Street.
"From the intersection of Alameda Boulevard and Maryland Avenue (West Sacramento); thence along Maryland Avenue, lgth Street and Virginia Avenue to 16th Street.
"Over Jefferson Boulevard between its junctions with 25 th Street and Merkley Avenue; thence over Merkley Avenue between Jefferson Boulevard and Park Boulevard (West Sacramento).
"Over U. S. Highway No. 40 between Park Boulevard (West Sacramento) and fth Street (Broderick).
"Beginning at the intersection of 0. S. Highway No. 40 and Westacre Road (West steramento); thence over Westacre Road, Michigan Avenue, Poplar Avenue, Evergreen Avenue and Westacre Road to its Intersection with Park Boulevard."

Said Decisions Nos. 40469 and $45+88$ shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
