SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decisions Nos. 48756 and 48757 of June 24, 1953, and 48926 of August 4, 1953, in the above-entitled proceedings, established revised minimum rates for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in bulk in tank vehicles. They required that tariff publications of common carriers be made effective by October 1, 1953. J. P. Haynes, Agent of the Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, requests that the time for complying with these tariff requirements be extended to November 1, 1953.

Petitioner represents that he must revise his rail petroleum tariff completely and that due to the volume of work involved it is physically impossible to make the required tariff filings within the specified time.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. No objection has been offered to its being granted.

In the circumstances, it appears that the sought extension of time should be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary. Inasmuch as the present time limit is October 1, 1953, the order herein will be made effective immediately.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second ordering paragraphs of Decisions Nos. 48756 of June 24, 1953, and 48926 of August 4, 1953, be and they are hereby amended by substituting "November 1, 1953," for the dates shown therein.

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 48756 and 48926 shall remain in full force and effect.
