## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Citizens Utilities Company of California in its First
Supplemental Application, filed September 2, 1953, in the aboveentitled proceeding seeks modification of this Commission's
Decision No. 48805, issued July 7, 1953, so as to permit it to place
in effect a more appropriate interconnection plan and construction
program than that originally contemplated for the integration of the
former Lorenzo Water Works system with applicant's existing Boulder
Creek system. By the plan and program now before us applicant will
better augment its over-all water supply and at the same time assure
that there will be no lessening of the supply or pressure served to
customers on the former Lorenzo system.

It appears that applicant's present proposal, when placed in full effectiveness, will adequately meet the intent of the applicable portions of our said Decision No. 48805 and we are of the opinion that applicant's request and proposal are reasonable and should be granted. A public hearing in this supplemental application does not appear to be necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the aforesaid Decision
No. 48805 is modified to the extent necessary to substitute, for the
numbered ordering paragraphs therein set forth, the following:

- 4. Citizens Utilities Company of California shall complete, on or before November 15, 1953, the construction program necessary to effect the interconnection of its present system with the acquired system in accordance with the plan and map set forth in its first supplemental application herein.
- 5. On or before December 5, 1953, Citizens Utilities Company of California shall file with this Commission four copies of a comprehensive map, drawn to an indicated scale of not smaller than 400 feet to the inch, clearly delineating by appropriate markings the parcels of land and the location and composition of other items of utility property transferred and, in addition, by distinctively coded or colored markings, showing the details of system interconnection and resulting system schematic diagram.

In all other respects Decision No. 48805 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
