FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 49181, dated October 6, 1953, the Commission authorized F. O. Culy, et al., to transfer operative rights and properties to Culy Transportation Co., Inc. Ordering Paragraph 4 of the order in the decision required Culy Transportation Co., Inc. to file appropriate tariffs and time tables within 60 days after the effective date of the Commission's order.

It now appears that Culy Transportation Co., Inc. has decided to complete the acquisition of the rights and properties as of January 1, 1954, which is after the expiration of the 60-day period specified in the Commission's order. Consequently, it has requested the Commission to modify its order so as to extend the time for filing the tariffs and time tables.

The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion it should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 4 of the order in Decision No. 49181, dated October 6, 1953, be, and it hereby is, modified to read as follows:

"4. Within 90 days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Culy Transportation Co., Inc. shall file, in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs and time tables."

This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
