SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 46800 of February 26, 1952 established point-to-point class rates between Los Angeles and Santa Ana on the same basis as the distance class rates for 30 to 35 miles. It has been pointed out that the general adjustment made by Decision No. 48958 of August 10, 1953 does not fully maintain this rate relationship. The necessary revisions should be made in the Los Angeles-Santa Ana rates. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" of Decision No. 31606 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective November 14, 1953, Third Revised Page 44-A Cancels Second Revised Page 44-A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariff publications of common carrier respondents filed pursuant to this order may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

In all other respects said Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the effective date hereof.
