SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 49068 dated September 15, 1953, in Application No. 34218, M. D. Peters and W. F. Peters were granted certain extensions of their operative rights as highway common carriers for the transportation of general commodities. By their petition for amendment of Decision No. 49068 filed with the Commission on September 30, 1953, applicants allege that the decision issued described applicants as M. D. Peters and W. F. Peters. By Decision No. 44034 dated April 11, 1950, in Application No. 30007, M. D. Peters was described as Myron D. Peters and W. F. Peters as Walter F. Peters.

It is further alleged that the rules of the Interstate Commerce Commission require that prior to the registration of intrastate rights for the purpose of obtaining corresponding interstate authority, the holders be described identically as they were described in the original certificate. For this reason, it is asserted, the certificate granting the extension in Decision No. 49068 cannot be registered with the Interstate Commerce Commission. It is therefore requested that said decision be amended to reflect the names of the applicants in the same manner as reflected in Decision No. 44034.

Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That paragraph (1) of Decision No. 49068 dated September 15, 1953, in Application No. 34218, is hereby amended by substituting the words "Walter F. Peters and Myron D. Peters" in lieu of the words "M. D. Peters and W. F. Peters."

(2) That the words "Walter F. Peters and Myron D. Peters" are hereby substituted for the words "M. D. Peters and W. F. Peters" wherever the same may appear in said Decision No. 49068.

(3) That in all other respects Decision No. 49068 shall remain in full force and effect.
