It appearing by Decision No. 34216, dated May 20, 1941, in Application No. 23720, that John Frank Nolan and Carl Simon were authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers between Sharps Park and Edgemar, on the one hand, and the intersection of Junipero Serra Boulevard and Portola Drive in the City of San Francisco, on the other hand; it further appearing that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage is now on file with the Commission by said John Frank Nolan and Carl Simon, as required by Goneral Order No. 101; and it further appearing after investigation by this Commission that the abovedescribed operation has been discontinued without any authorization to suspend or discontinue same; therefore, it is found that John Frank Nolan and Carl Simon are no longer conducting and have unlawfully abandoned said passenger stage operation.

Good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to John Frank Nolan and Carl Simon by Decision No. 34216 in the above-entitled proceeding is hereby revoked and

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon John Frank Nolan and Carl Simon, unless said John Frank Nolan and Carl Simon before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission 2 written response to this order; denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
