ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional drill track at grade across Williams Street in the City of San Leandro, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. L-15.5. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the readway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by three existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear ontire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the City of San Leandro is presently engaged in widening and improving Williams Street and authority to

immediately install said drill track will expedite these improvements, therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
