FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant has requested a temporary deviation from a condition under which authority was granted in Decision No. 47124 to construct, maintain and operate railroad tracks at grade or separated grades across various public streets and highways as shown in and described by said decision. Specifically, applicant desires to start operating on October 26, 1953, over Crossing No. 3-17.9 (Hacienda Boulevard) as protected by existing Standard No. 8. crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) and prior to the additional installation of automatic crossing gates, said gates being a requirement to one of the conditions under which authorization of this project was previously granted.

Applicant has stated that installation of these required automatic crossing gates will be completed in early November of this year, alleging that emergency work elsewhere has necessitated the removal of signal forces of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, the party which is responsible by agreement for the signal work required in installing said gates.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the applicant is hereby authorized to operate over proposed track at Crossing No. 3-17.9 (Hacienda Boulevard) as shown in and described by Decision No. 47124 providing said crossing be protected by:

- (1) Two existing Standard No. 8 crossing signals  
(General Order No. 75-B)
- (2) One human flagman

Upon completion of installation of the proposed automatic crossing gates, the protection of this crossing by a human flagman will no longer be required and the terms and stipulations of Decision No. 47124 will be in full force and effect. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall be effective for a period of thirty days from the date hereof.
