ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing from the Commission files that Pacific Union College once operated a passenger stage service between Pacific Union College and St. Helena as indicated by its currently effective tariff; it further appearing that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage has ever been filed with the Commission by said Pacific Union College, as required by General Order No. 101; and it further appearing after investigation by this Commission that the above-described operation has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue same; therefore, it is found that Pacific Union College is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage operation.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that whatever operative rights that may have been acquired by Pacific Union College to transport passengers between Pacific Union College and St. Helena are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Pacific Union College are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Pacific Union College in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth

day after lawful service thereof upon Pacific Union College, unless said Pacific Union College or its duly authorized representative, before such effective date, shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
