<u>OPINION</u>

In the above-entitled application Pacific Greyhound Lines requests the Commission to redefine all of its urban routes within the City of Sacramento and include therein certain additional urban routes. The additional routes proposed are as follows:

- From the junction of Sixteenth Street and F Street, over Sixteenth Street to H Street to Eighth Street to L Street (with the presently authorized route between Sixteenth Street and Seventh Street to be eliminated).
- 2. From the junction of Seventh Street and I Street, over I Street to Eighth Street.
- 3. From the junction of Third Street and L Street, over L Street to Seventh Street.
- 4. From the junction of Fifth Street and I Street, over Fifth Street to Capitol Avenue.

In justification for the authority sought, applicant states that the municipal authorities for the City of Sacramento have for a considerable period been progressively establishing regulations which will serve to develop a less obstructed flow of traffic on the city's congested thoroughfares which includes the designation of certain streets for one-way traffic. Applicant states it has been informed the plans for one-way streets have already been partly consummated. It is contemplated that the plans will be completed on or before November 1, 1953. It is stated that the proposals are for the purpose of conforming with those municipal regulations as they now or

soon will apply to the directional movement of automotive traffic. Applicant's present fares and schedules will apply to the proposed routings.

After full consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and operation of passenger stage service by applicant over the routes proposed. No protest to the application has been received and it will be granted. No public hearing appears to be necessary.

<u>ORDER</u>

An application having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes described in Urban Routes UR-10.01 to and including UR-10.12 as set forth in First Revised Page 76 and First Revised Page 76-A of Appendix A which is attached hereto.

(2) That Appendix A of Decision No. 47907, Application No. 31883, is hereby amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 76 and First Revised Page 76-A as referred to in paragraph (1) of this order.

(3) That the operative authority herein granted is consolidated with and made a part of the operative rights created by Decision No. 47907 and is subject to all the provisions as set forth therein.

(4) That within thirty days after the effective date thereof applicant shall file appropriate and satisfactory maps for the Commission delineating the routes herein authorized.

- *UR-10.09 From the junction of I Street and Fifth Street, over Fifth Street to Capitol Avenue.
