In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of industrial spur track across the northerly roadway of Raymer Street in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Raymor Street in the City of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application. Raymer Street is not improved at the point of crossing, and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the spur track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that one of the industries to be served by this trackage has indicated an early need for receipt of carload shipments, and accordingly requests that the order,

if granted, be made effective immediately. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
